# GENERAL SHOW RULES

- 1 This Show is conducted subject to the rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies, the constitution and rules of this Society and any regulation which appears within the Schedule for individual sections of this Show.
- 2 The Society engages the services of Security Personnel to assist with the provision of care of all exhibits, livestock and property, and whilst all reasonable care is taken by the Society, the Society cannot accept any responsibility for any loss or damage to or by any exhibits, livestock, equipment, vehicles or any other property.
- 3 All persons, not members, shall pay admittance to the show unless otherwise provided with a pass by the Secretary.
- 4 Exhibitors and persons admitted to the grounds shall be subject to the Rules of the Society.
- 5 The Society reserves the right to refuse admittance of any exhibit where there is reason to suspect it is either diseased or dangerous, or to remove any such exhibit from the show.
- 6 Exhibits not in accordance with the printed requirements will not be judged.
- 7 Please read the Schedule carefully as entries received after the deadline for closing will not be accepted.
- 8 The lodgement of early entries for all sections of the show (except the Ring Events where entries are 'on the day') will greatly assist Stewards in the smooth running of the show.
- 9 No pavilion exhibits to have won first prize in any previous Noosa Country Show.
- 10 Pavilion will be CLOSED for judging from 12 noon till 4pm on both Wednesday 8th and Thursday 9th September 2010. Squash Courts will be closed Thursday 9th September 2010.
- 11 No exhibitors will be allowed in the pavilion or Squash Courts during judging.
- 12 No exhibits to be removed from the pavilion or Squash Courts before 6pm on Saturday 11th September.
- 13 All exhibits to be collected from the downstairs pavilion between 6pm and 7pm on Saturday 11th September OR Sunday 12th between 9am - 12pm. Any uncollected exhibits will be available from the Secretary's office or by contacting the Show Secretary.
- 14 Entry fees and prize money will be stated in the individual sections.
- 15 Prize money for downstairs pavilion events may be collected from the Prize Table at the pavilion from 6pm on Saturday 11th September 2010 on presentation of the prize certificate.
- 16 Prize money for upstairs pavilion events may be collected from the Prize Table at the pavilion on Sunday 12th September between 9am- 12pm on presentation of the prize certificate.
- 17 Any prize money unclaimed by 30th September 2010 will be forfeited to the Society.
- 18 Championship ribbons will be awarded to the Champion Exhibit in each section at the discretion of the Judge.
- 19 The Judges decision is final.
- 20 Where any conflict may arise between the above rules and special rules for individual sections, the special rules shall prevail.
