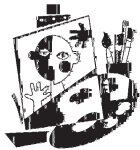

### Classes

1. **Open** - any subject, any medium. Entry: \$10. 1<sup>st</sup> Prize: \$500 - Noosa Country Show Award
2. **Traditional** - My Local Landscape/seascape oils & acrylics - Entry \$5. 1<sup>st</sup> Prize \$250
3. **Contemporary** - any medium- Entry \$5. 1<sup>st</sup> Prize \$250
4. **Watercolour** - Entry: \$5. 1<sup>st</sup> Prize \$250
5. **Themed Subject** - "Moving forward during 100 years" any medium- Entry \$5. 1<sup>st</sup> Prize \$250
6. **Novice** - any subject, any medium Entry: \$4.50. 1<sup>st</sup> Prize \$200 (Novice must not have won in previous shows.)
7. **Mixed Media** - any subject Entry: \$5. 1<sup>st</sup> Prize \$250
8. **Abstract** - Entry: \$5. 1<sup>st</sup> Prize \$250

## General Conditions of Entry

1. All entries are subject to General Show Rules.
2. Entries must be original work of exhibitor being completed within the last two years before this Show.
3. All exhibits will be judged. The judge's decision is final.
4. All works must be suitable for general public exhibition.
5. Exhibits (including Novice) which have been awarded a prize previously, anywhere, will not be accepted.
6. All decisions regarding the Noosa Country Show Arts Festival will be the ultimate responsibility of the co-ordinator and no further discussion will be entered into.
7. Entry form must be fully completed and signed by the entrant. Entry fees must accompany the entry form. NO late entry forms accepted.
8. Paintings must be suitably framed and ready to hang with cord or wire on 'D' hooks and must not exceed 1.2m width or height, including frame. No fishing line to be used.
9. Title, Medium, Price, Name, Address and contact number of artist are to be clearly printed on the back/underneath (left hand corner) of each work or will not be accepted.
10. All reasonable care will be taken of exhibits. The Show Society will not accept liability for loss or damage.
11. The co-ordinator reserves the right to reclassify any entries not complying with class criteria and/or conditions
12. Entries must be received at Pomona Squash Courts in Showground, Pavilion Street, Pomona between 9.30am and 3.30pm on Saturday 5th September 2009.
13. **All works must be for sale.** Prices must be in whole dollars (inclusive of GST) and 25% commission which will be used by the Show Society to help fund this and any future festivals. Cheques for works sold or acquired will be posted approximately four weeks after the close of the Show. A Statement of Supply **must** accompany each entry form.
14. Class tickets will be available on delivery of exhibits and must be fixed to front of painting.
15. Exhibitors agree to permit reproduction of their work for promotional purposes. The signed entry form is evidence of the exhibitor's consent.

16. Prizes can be collected during the Show or on Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> September between 9am and midday. Any prize not claimed by 12th October 2009 will be forfeited to the Noosa A. H & I Society Inc.
17. Exhibits must be collected between 9.30am and midday on Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> September 2009. Proof of ownership will be required for collection of exhibit. If there are any exhibits not collected by 12th October 2009, exhibits will become the property of Noosa A. H. & I Society Inc. and will be dealt with at their discretion.
18. All works will be on exhibition until end of Show. Exhibits sold can be collected on Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> September 2009 with presentation of proof of purchase. No works to be collected before this time.
19. Diptych - Two pieces within 1.2m maximum width and height.
20. Triptych - Three pieces within 1.2m maximum width and height.
21. Freight works must arrive no later than Friday 28th August 2009. All expenses in conjunction with forwarding, packing, repacking, returning and insurance of entries shall be borne by the competitor. The Co-ordinator accepts no responsibility for loss or damage. It is recommended that all exhibitors undertake their own insurance

## Additional Special Rules Section 12B - Pottery

1. Judging will commence after 9am Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> September 2009.
