

# Miss Noosa Showgirl

## Conditions of Entry

The following conditions apply for the Miss Noosa Showgirl Awards.

1. Entrants must be single, aged 18 years and under 27 years on the 1st August in the year of the Competition. The Miss Showgirl Awards is open to girls born in Australia or naturalised Australians.
2. Eligible entrants residing outside Queensland who can prove an affinity with a Queensland Show are allowed entry by satisfying one of the following criteria:
  - a. their address has a Queensland postcode;
  - b. they have a Queensland phone number; or
  - c. the entrant or the entrant's parents are active working members of that Show.
4. The ultimate winner must remain single until the conclusion of the Royal Queensland Show. Entrants must not have been married or have had a child.
5. An entrant must have been judged on 22<sup>nd</sup> August at the Pomona Showgrounds at 10am. For Miss Noosa Showgirl class only the Completion of judging will take place at the show ball on Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> August.
6. In the event of the local winner being unable to attend Sub-Chamber judging, the runner-up is eligible to compete.
7. Prospective entrants who are employed or are still in fulltime studies are advised to ascertain in advance that they are able to obtain leave of absence to attend Sub-Chamber and State Final Judging if chosen to represent their local area. The State finalists will be required to be in Brisbane the day prior to and the first three (3) days of the Royal Queensland Show. The ultimate Miss Showgirl winner must remain in Brisbane to perform official duties up to and including the 'People's Day' holiday of the Royal Queensland Show.
8. Should a finalist win a prize or title and does not abide by the above conditions, she will not be eligible for further participation in the Miss Showgirl Awards and will automatically forfeit all prizes and title associated with the Miss Showgirl Awards Final.
