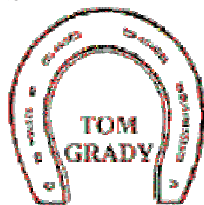

SPECIAL REGULATIONS FOR CATTLE

- All entries are subject to General Show Rules.
- All exhibitors must pay admission fees.
- In cases where there is no competition the judges use their own discretion to award a Prize or not.
- All cattle must be thoroughly tractable. All single exhibits are to be led into the ring or they will not be judged. The Steward is to hold discretionary powers to enforce this regulation.
- Exhibitors making false entries or giving false pedigrees for animals in this section shall forfeit all prizes won at this Show.
- Animals shall only wear ribbons won at this Show All prize winners shall appear and parade on the day of the Show. Prizes are likely to be forfeited by anyone breaking these rules.
- A heifer is a female animal not exceeding 3 years.
- Stewards must not wear the Society's badge whilst leading their exhibits in the judging.
- All persons causing a nuisance by loud comments on the decision of the judges or other insulting remarks or unseemly behaviour, will, after being cautioned, be expelled from the Showgrounds and in the case of exhibitors be liable for disqualification.
- Stewards shall have the power to turn out any beast from the judging ring if they think it is not in the proper class.
- In bull and progeny class, the progeny need not be the property of the owner of the sire.
- In the dairy class in which the age of the exhibit is a condition, the entry form shall state the actual date of birth, ie. Date, month, year. Age for classification shall be that on June 1.
- All cattle exhibited must be TUBERCULOSIS tested according to DPI rules.
- Only cattle approved by the Herd Book Societies will be accepted for entries.
- All animals must be free from ticks.
- All exhibits in this section must be in the grounds not later than 8.00am on Friday 11th September.
- No stud cattle will be allowed entry to Pomona Showgrounds unless accompanied by a stock permit endorsed by a permanent Inspector of Stock that such cattle comply with health test requirements for BRUCELLOSIS and TUBERCULOSIS.
- ENZOOTIC BOVINE LEUCOSIS
 - From herds classified as accredited free (AF) - no test required.
 - Dairy cattle more than six months of age other than those from E.B.L. Accredited Free herds - one negative test within six months prior to entry to the showgrounds.



NOTE

A certificate of Accreditation or a Veterinary Certificate showing negative testing as required must accompany any exhibits or entry to the showgrounds my be refused ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE NLIS TAGGED. REMINDER TO ALL, EXIBITORS TO LODGE HOME MOVEMENTS.
