2. Limit of six entries per category per person.
3. **Exhibit Collection:** Pomona Squash Courts, Pomona Showgrounds from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Sunday, 15th September 2024.
4. **Junior Champion Exhibitor:** Awarded by the Judges for the best of the six first place winners.
5. The Steward reserves the right to reclassify or reject entries not complying with topics or entry requirements.
6. All entries must be the original work of the exhibitor.
7. All entries are subject to General Show Rules.
8. All works must be suitable for general viewing.
9. The Stewards decision is final.
10. No previous winning Photos (1st, 2nd, HC) accepted.
11. The Noosa A.H. & I. Society Inc. accepts no responsibility for loss or damage.
12. The officials of the Noosa Country Show will exercise all reasonable care with exhibits.
13. All exhibits judged.
14. The Noosa A.H. & I. Society Inc. reserves the right to reproduce any pictures of work in the press, TV or on social media.
15. Exhibitor's submission of entry implies acceptance of all conditions listed and the General Show Rules.
16. Prize money, ribbons and certificates issued by Steward at time of exhibit collection.

EXHIBITING REQUIREMENTS

1. Prints submitted **MUST** be a print only or with a flush backing mounting e.g. cardboard or thick paper. No borders. If a mount is used, there must be none sticking out from the sides of the photo.
2. All entries will be hung with sticky Velcro tabs on the back (we supply and affix).
3. All photographs to be approximately A4 size e.g. 8"x12" or 8"x10" depending on your camera's ratio. You can crop image to different proportions for overall effect.
4. Name of exhibitor should **NOT** appear on front.
5. Exhibitor's name, contact number, photo title, class and division should be written on a separate piece of paper or sticker and attached to the back of print, avoiding writing imprint through to the surface – print only entries.
6. Strongly recommended to submit photos with a piece of paper or fabric between each one, placed in a folder with your name and division on the outside of folder.
7. The use of AI (Artificial Intelligence) is **NOT** allowed.

CLASSES

Class 1 It's Showtime - At Noosa Country Show

This may be a photo taken at any one of our Noosa Country Shows (must be Noosa only). Show us the fun of the fair using your photographic flair!

Class 2 The Beach to the Bush - Landscape Photography

Capture the majesty of the mountains or the beauty of the beaches, or anything in between. Create a landscape photography that captures the natural beauty of the region and beyond.

Class 3 Macro - Up close and personal

Flowers, bees, insects, fungi, and more, they are all amazing when captured up close and personal. Show us how up close and personal you can get!

Class 4 Out and About - Street Photography

Street photography with or without people, in colour or monochrome. Create an image that captures the detail, the mundane, the art, the architecture, the people, the quiet, or the bustle of everyday life in town.

Class 5 Creativity - Let your imagination run wild!

Create an abstract or altered reality image using your own photographs. This can include combining multiple images and manipulating in-camera and/or post-processing. All elements of the final image must be the work of the photographer.

Class 6 Mobile Phone Photography - 'People underestimate how amazing photographs taken with mobile phones can be'. Amaze us with your creation, captured and edited entirely on your phone. Images shot and edited on any mobile phone or tablet including iPhones, iPads, Android phones and tablets, Windows Phones, and the iPod touch are eligible for entry.
