Printmaking

May include Screen Printing, Etching, Dry Point printing and Lino printing. A4 or A3 Paper presentation.

Must be presented on A4 Paper with grade appropriate lines.

Years Prep - Year 1: List 4 words describing Koalas.

Year 2 - Year3: Write a sentence or 2 beginning with "Koala's are"

Photography Exhibiting Requirements

1. Prints submitted **MUST** be a print only or with a flush backing mounting e.g. cardboard or thick paper. No boarders. If a mount is used, there must be none sticking out from the sides of the photo.
2. All entries hung with sticky Velcro tabs on the back (we supply and affix).
3. All photographs to be approx. A4 size e.g. 8x12", 8x10" depending on your camera's ratio. You can crop image to different proportions for overall effect.
4. Name of exhibitor should **NOT** appear on front.
5. Exhibitor's name, contact number, photo title, class and division should be written on a separate piece of paper or sticker and attach to the back of print, avoiding writing imprint through to the surface – print only entries.

6. Strongly recommended to submit photos with a piece of paper or fabric between each one, placed in a folder with your name and division on the outside of folder

Class 15038 Chocolate Cake Recipe - Class 15037

Ingredients:

*1 tin Nestle Sweetened Condensed Milk or 395g
100g butter melted
225ml water
2 teaspoons vanilla essence or 10g
200g plain flour
Two eggs
One egg yolk
1-cup cocoa powder or 100g
1-tablespoon baking powder or 15g
1-teaspoon baking soda or 5g
1-teaspoon salt
1-tablespoon yoghurt*

For the icing:

*2 tablespoons butter or 30g, softened
4 tablespoons cocoa powder ¼-cup icing sugar
1½ tablespoons boiling water*

Method:

*1. Combine the NESTLE Sweetened Condensed Milk, melted butter, water and vanilla essence in a large bowl. Sift together the flour, cocoa, baking powder and baking soda. Stir the dry ingredients into the condensed milk mixture until just combined.
2. Pour the mixture into a lined 23cm spring form cake tin. Bake in a preheated 175°C oven for 45 minutes or until a cake skewer inserted into the centre of the cake comes out clean. Cool on a wire rack for 10 minutes then remove from tin and cool completely. Ice top when cold.
3. To prepare the icing, place butter in bowl. Add the sifted cocoa and icing sugar and sufficient boiling water to mix to a smooth but firm consistency.*
